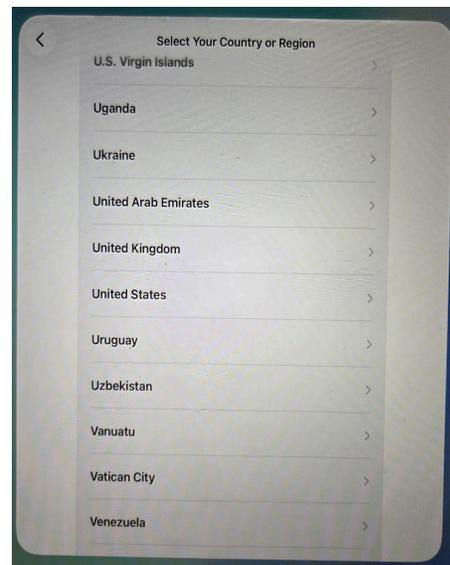
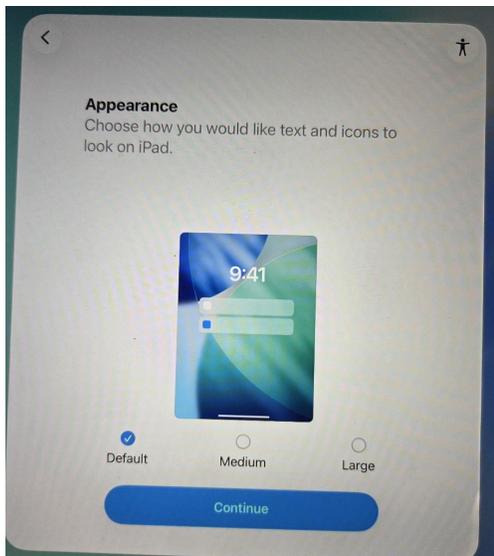
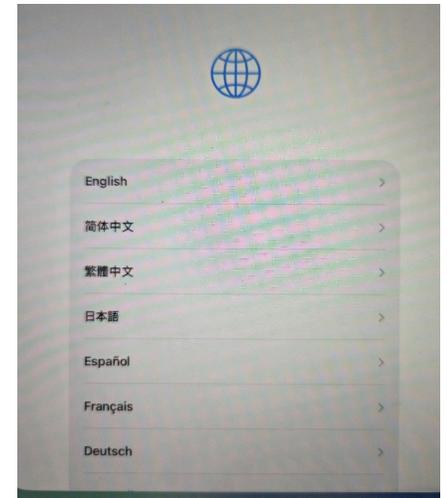
## Setup Guide for iPad A16 (11 Gen)

### POWER ON

- Press and hold the Top (Power) button until the Apple logo appears.
- Swipe up when you see "Hello."

### PREFERENCES

- Then, choose your desire language
- Select your country/region
- Select the appearance of how you want your text and icons to look on your iPad

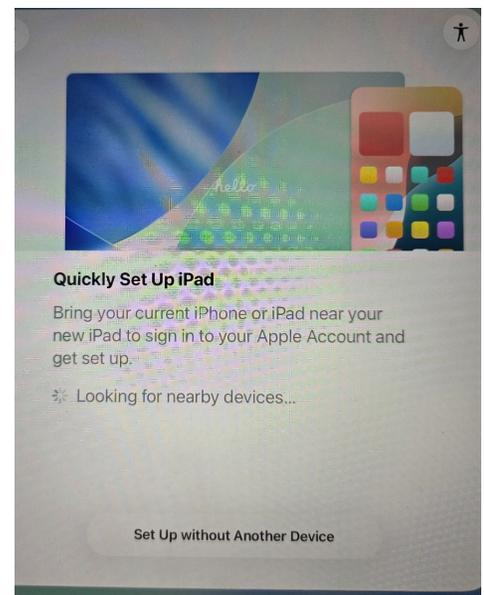


### PASSCODE

You need to set up the required six-digit passcode and can make it as simple or as complicated as you want. Try to create a passcode that is easy enough for you to remember but tough enough for anybody else to guess. Once you put it in the first time it will ask you to reenter the passcode and then you can move on in the process.

## SET-UP OPTIONS

- You will be asked if you want to restore a previous or existing device. **PLEASE DO NOT RESTORE or SETUP FROM ANOTHER DEVICE.**
- Choose the selection at the bottom of the screen "Set Up without Another Device"



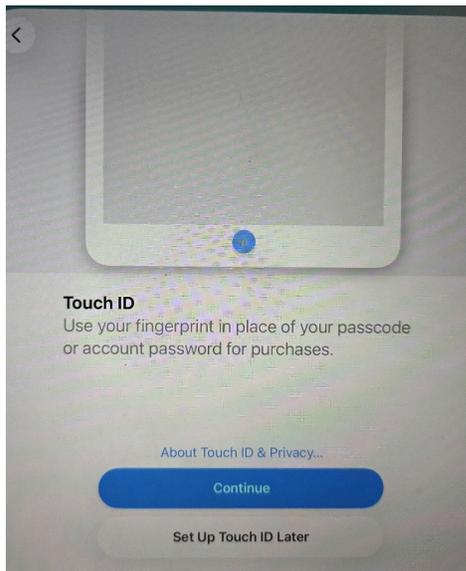
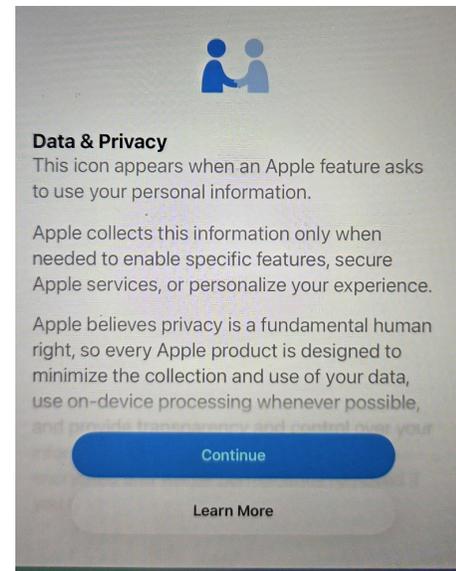
## WI-FI

Connect to **Wi-Fi**. This is a very important step in the setup process. For you to complete the setup and get all of the applications loaded you need to be connected to the internet.



## DATA + PRIVACY

Confirm the Data & Privacy policy by clicking on "Continue" at the bottom of the screen.



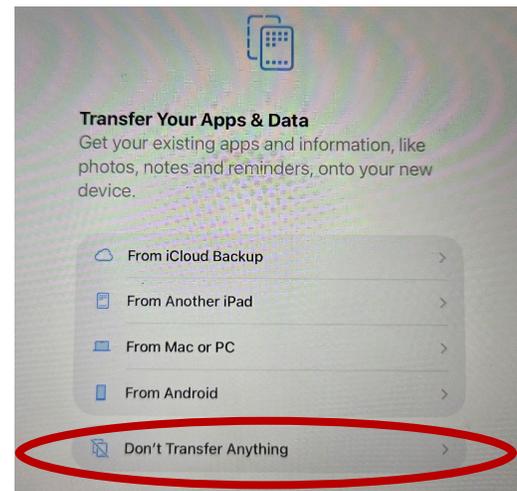
## TOUCH ID

Set Up your Touch ID. This is a great feature that allows you to use your fingers to access the data on your device.

# CAHE-MANAGED IPAD

When you get your iPad the Center for Allied Health manages your device. This ensures that you will have all the required applications for school. This does not mean that you cannot load other applications, however CAHE wants to ensure that you have all the items needed to be successful in your program.

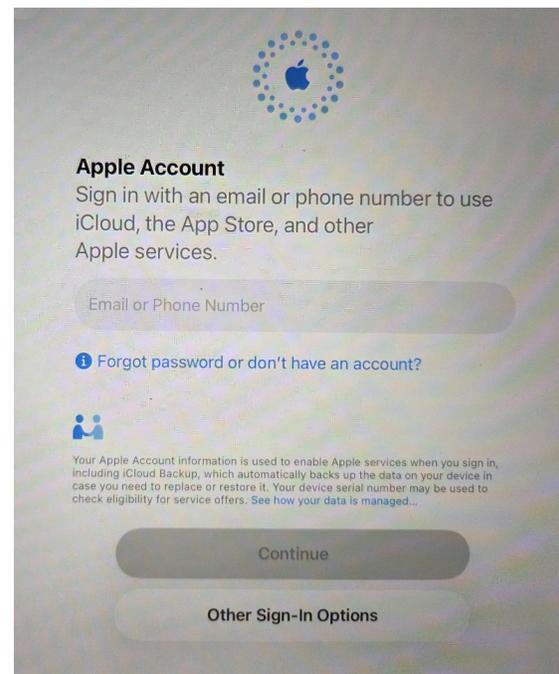
When you complete your program and leave the center you will be instructed on how to have the iPad released from CAHE control and you will be able to use the iPad unmanaged.

## APPLE ID SIGN-IN

- You must have an Apple ID and be signed in with it on your new device.
- If you have an existing Apple ID, Enter your **Apple ID + password**
- Complete **two-factor authentication** if you have it setup.
- Agree to Terms & Conditions and move to the next steps.
- If you do not have an Apple ID, you can use your new student email address to create an Apple ID. To create an Apple ID, click on "Forgot password or don't have an account?" option in the middle of the screen.

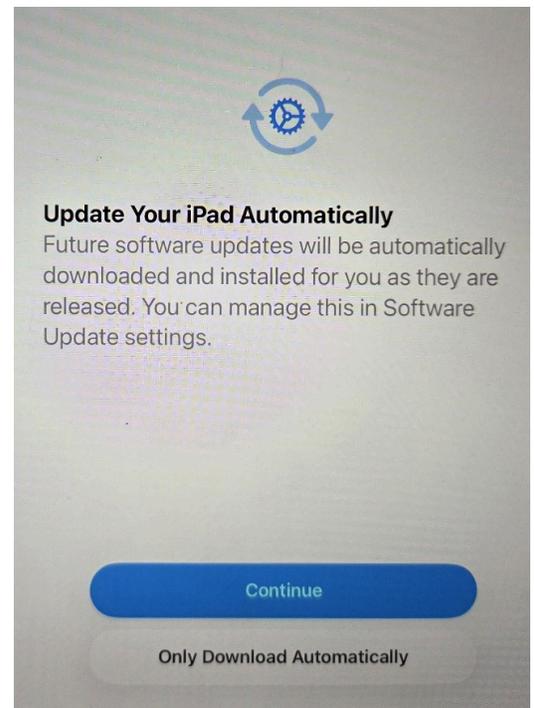
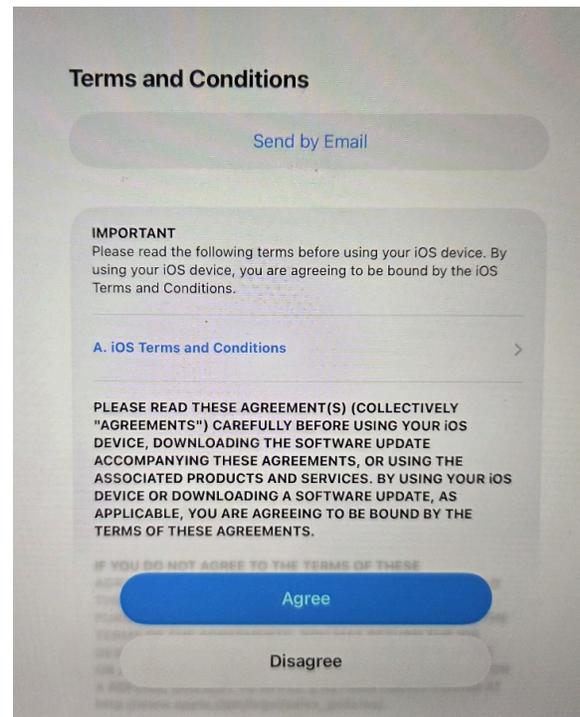
You must click “Agree” to the Terms & Conditions at the bottom of the screen to complete the setup.

You will have several other applications or service that are available to you. These are Recommended to be setup during the initial install. Just as a reminder you if you choose during the initial setup not to install these applications, you can always go back and set them up.

## Automatic iPad OS Updates

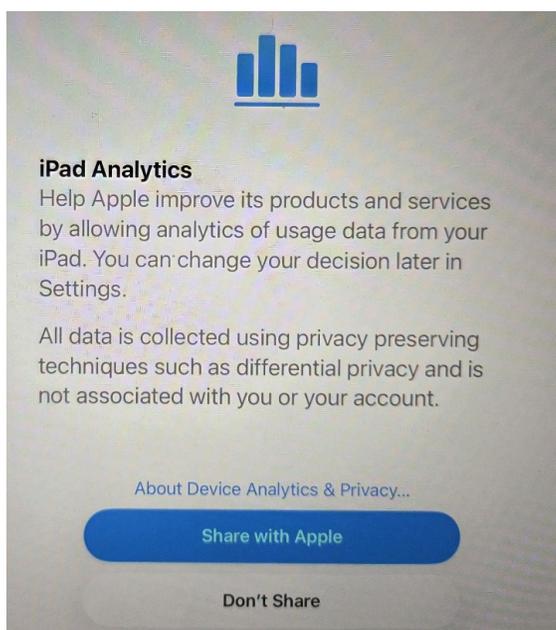
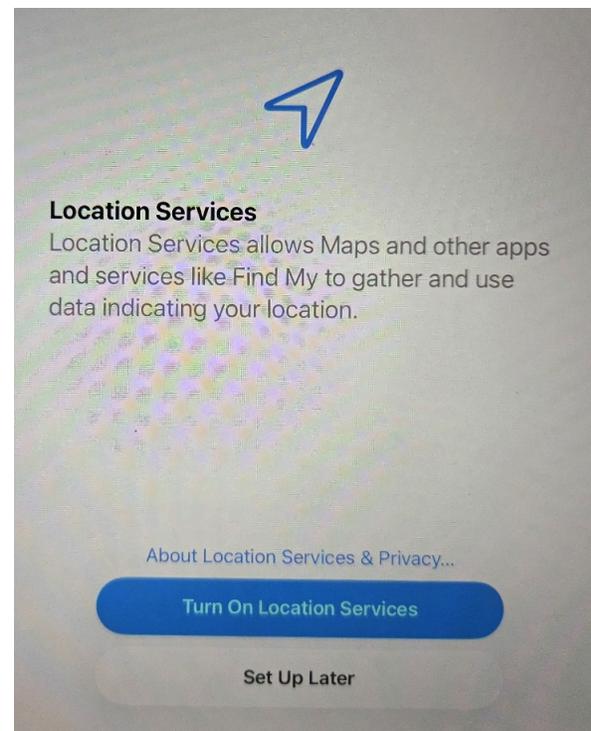
This ensures that your iPad is always up-to-date. There are two options. If you simply click continue your device will automatically try to download and run the all updates as they become available. You will be prompted to begin the download and update process.

If you select the “Only Download Automatically” you device will check for downloads, if they are available they will be downloaded but you will be responsible for installing the updates.



## Location Services

Should be turned on during the install. During your program you will be going to clinical sites for rotations. You will be required to clock in and clock out using one of the applications on your device. The application using “Geo-Fencing” to ensure you are in the correct location for your rotations.



## iPad Analytics

This is an optional setting during setup that lets your iPad send diagnostic and usage information to Apple. Its purpose is to help Apple improve iPadOS performance, stability, and features.

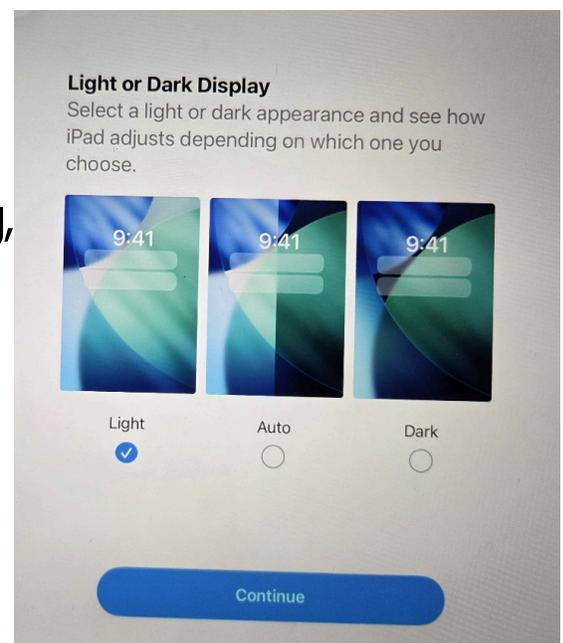
## Display Mode

When you set up a new iPad, Apple asks whether you want Light or Dark display.

**Light Mode** → Best for daytime use, reading, and maximum clarity

**Dark Mode** → Best for night use, reduced eye strain, and OLED-style aesthetics (even though iPads use LCD)

You can change this anytime, so your choice during setup is not permanent.

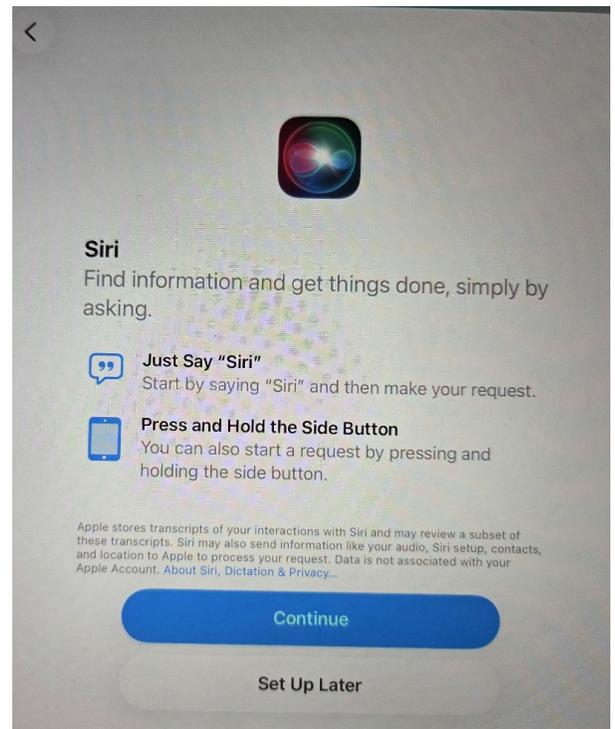


# Set Up Siri & Apple intelligence

## What is Apple Intelligence?

Apple Intelligence is Apple's built-in AI system that works directly on your device (and securely with Apple servers when needed). The A16 chip is powerful enough to handle many of these tasks locally, which means:

- Faster responses
- Better privacy
- Less reliance on the cloud

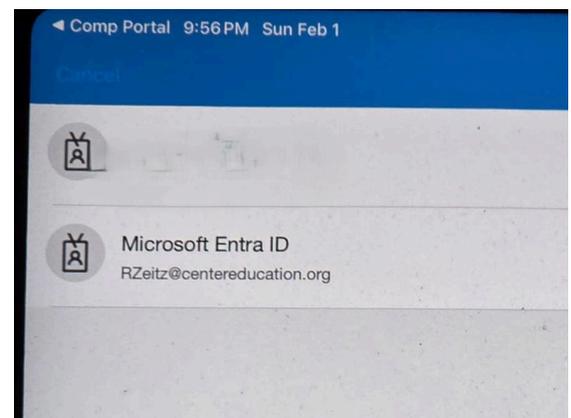
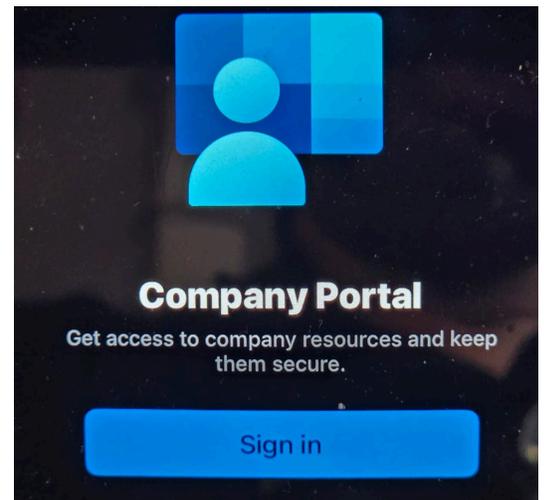


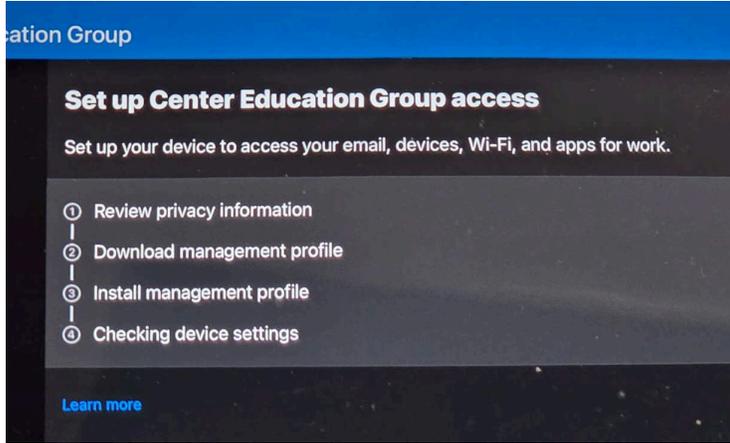
## Starting Company Portal

Once you complete the iPad setup you need to launch the Intune Company Portal. This will initial the setup of the device and start the download/installation of the apps needed.

You will need to sign-in to the Company Portal. Use your new school email and password to login and begin the setup.

Choose the correct email account from you authenticator app and enter your password and your authenticator number. The setup and verification process will now begin





## Company Portal (con.)

This is the first of the 4 sections that you will go through to setup the company portal. The begin button will appear of the screen.

Click "Begin" to continue

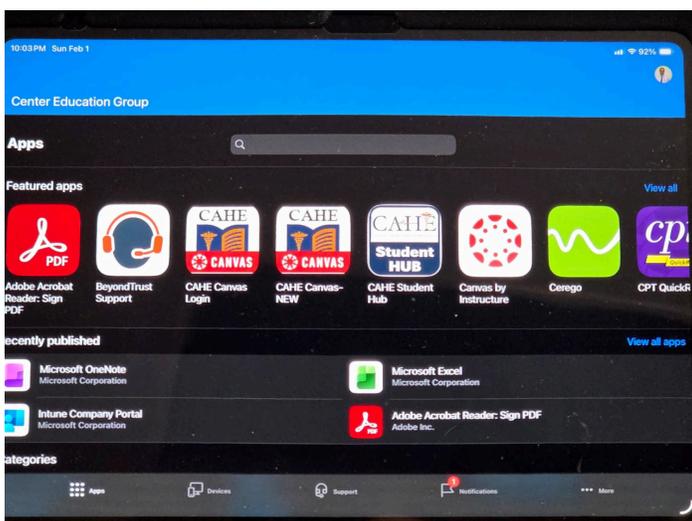
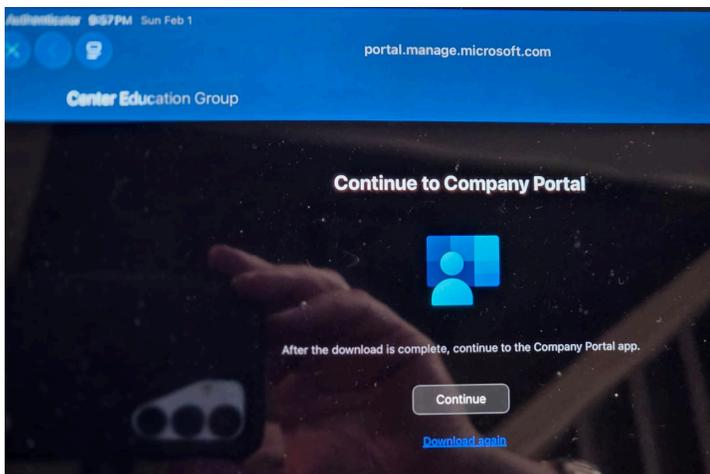
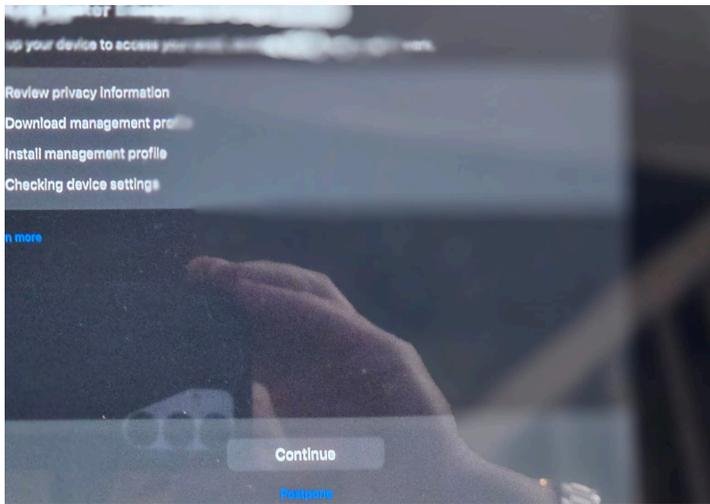
You will need to confirm the privacy information by clicking "Continue" you will be brought to the privacy information screen.

Then, click "Continue to begin the download of the CEG management profile.

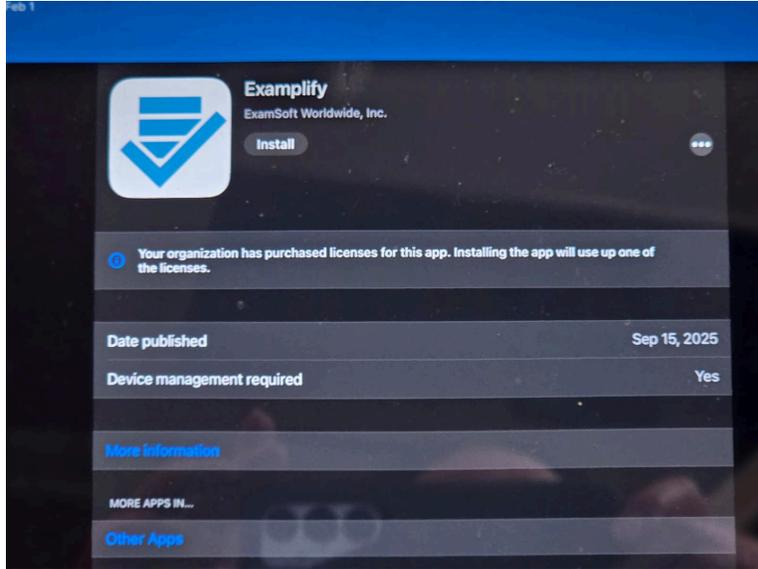
Continue to the Company Portal to begin the installation of the apps on your device
